Application Requirements and Admission Procedure

Completed application, **including transcripts, recommendations, GRE scores (if applicable), and all other admission requirements** must be received no later than the posted deadline for priority review (see the posted deadlines at www.brandman.edu/nursing/admission/deadlines.asp). Applications that are late will be reviewed only if there is space available after the admission process (interviews and review) has been completed. Late applications that are not reviewed will be processed for the next application cycle.

A complete application packet **MUST** be submitted prior to the application deadline for priority review. Please ensure you have submitted all of the following items and fax or mail to:

- Apply to your desired degree program by completing the Brandman University Graduate application. Apply online at www.brandman.edu/apply
- Official transcripts from each institution attended. Have your transcripts from every college and university from which a Bachelors degree or higher was earned mailed to (**do not fax transcripts**):

- Submit a current and detailed resume (included in the online application)
- Complete the Self Evaluation and Goal Statement (included in the online application).
- Request Reference Forms: **Three recommendations are required.** Download the reference forms at: <https://www.brandman.edu/admission/applicationsPDF.asp>
 - a) Fill in your name and address in the space provided
 - b) Fill in the program to which you are applying to
 - c) Give a copy of the Reference Form to each individual who has agreed to serve as a reference for you
 - d) Appropriate References include the following:
 1. Your most recent employer/supervisor,
 2. A professor who can assess your professional and academic achievement if you have graduated in the last 5 years.
 3. A professional person (not a relative) who is well acquainted with your professional practice and academic achievement.

- If you are using **Option Two**, with a grade point average between 2.5 – 2.99, submit passing scores from one of the following standard admission tests:
- The Graduate Record Examination (GRE): Applicants must achieve the required minimum scores on two out of three of the subsections of the GRE or score at or above the 60th percentile on any one of the Graduate Subject Tests. (Minimum score for quantitative or verbal sections is 450. Minimum score for analytic writing is 4.5.). See web site: <http://www.ets.org/gre> or 1-800-473-2255
 - The Miller Analogies Test (MAT): a minimum raw scaled of 400. See web site: www.tpcweb.com or 1-800-622-3231
 - The Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT): fulfill the formula $GMAT + (GPA \times 200) > 1000$. See web site: www.gmat.org or 1-800-462-8669
