

**Student Right-to-Know Act
Annual Graduation/Completion Rate Report**

The following information about graduation/completion is exhibited for compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation/completion status of students who enrolled during the fall term of the 2004-05 academic year, and for whom 150% of normal completion time has elapsed. Differently than traditional institutions, the completion rates below are for students entering into Brandman University for their first time who may have earned prior academic credit at another institution. Our institution's definition of normal completion time is 6 years after entering our institution for the first time as an undergraduate.**†

Our advertised rate uses a 4-year cohort average to provide more reliable estimates of expected completion time for our prospective students.
